Art materials and board games will be provided inside, and outside there is an extensive secure playground with a variety of different pieces of play equipment for children to enjoy. We will also make sure there is a quiet area to escape to if needed.

This is a play session organised exclusively for children with autism and their siblings. Parents/carers must stay on site with their children at all times and are responsible for their own children at all times.

There is no need to book – just come along. No entry fee is charged but if you would like to make a donation to cover some of the costs then pop something in our collection box – donations are always gratefully received! Please feel free to bring your own healthy snacks – we will provide tea, coffee and soft drinks.

There is no on-site parking available at Walker School, but there is a free public car park next door which may have spaces and plenty of parking in the streets near the school. Several buses (229, 121, 298, W6) stop at The Green, close to the school, and Southgate Tube Station is approx. 10 mins walk away.
