Disability Advice Network Enfield (DANE) is a new FREE advice service for people with disabilities, health conditions or vulnerabilities.

DANE can assist you with:

- **Free, impartial information and advice** on disability rights, services, housing, welfare benefits, debt and independent living
- **Digital inclusion support**, including 1:1 training and group sessions to build confidence with technology
- **Assistive technology guidance**, helping residents safely and confidently use devices that support and enhance daily life
- **Help with** financial planning for later life and mental capacity advice
- **Mental health and wellbeing support activities**
- **Community-Based Outreach** – Local drop-ins at the 4 community hubs, Digital and wellbeing navigation services, and peer support to make help easy to find and access

Eligibility criteria

This service is for anyone with a disability, health condition or a vulnerability who lives in Enfield and is over 18 years of age
